

**VILLAGE OF NEW AUBURN
PLAN COMMISSION MEETING MINUTES**

The Planning Commission, Village of New Auburn, was held on Tuesday, May 17, 2022 at 6:00 pm at the Village Hall.

The purpose of the meeting will be to review and discuss the draft scope of work for the Comprehensive Plan update project.

3. Population and Housing Element – Review of projected population through 2040. To properly plan for New Auburn’s future requires an understanding of the community’s population, demographic trends, and housing base. Population trends influence all other plan elements such as the demand for community services, economic development policy, and land use. Housing trends are directly related to demands of the population.
4. Intergovernmental Cooperation Element – This element includes a compilation of goals, objectives, policies, and programs for joint planning and decision making with other jurisdictions. It will also identify existing and potential conflicts between the Village of New Auburn and other governmental units and should include processes to resolve such conflicts.
5. Economic Development Element – Through planning, a community can anticipate economic change and guide development to the best of its abilities to achieve the economic vision and objectives for the community. Economic development is about working together to maintain a strong economy which provides a good standard of living for individuals and a reliable tax base for the community. A community’s economic development plan should reflect the values of the community and must be carefully linked to the goals, objectives, and strategies of the other plan elements.
