Want to pay your water-sewer utility bill online? We contract with a 3rd party provider called AllPaid. Pay over the phone (888) 604-7888 or online at www.newauburn-wi.com. Available 24/7, 365 days per year. There are NO Fees using the web to pay your utility bill.

AVOID UTILITY LATE FEES

Village Hall would like to remind everyone that utility payments are always due around the 25th of each month with exceptions made for holidays. We strive to post payments made on the due date or early the following day prior to assessing late fees. We know that many of our residents like to pay online with AllPaid because it's easy and convenient but please know that if you pay on the due date or the day after, those payments do not post until the following day so to be safe and avoid late fees, please use the AllPaid option the 24th of each month before the due date. Thank you.

VILLAGE SEEKING ADDITIONAL GRANT FUNDING

Village staff are in the process of seeking grant funding from the State & US Governments. We are focused on improving our roads at this time to the best of our abilities. Additional funding will help the Village obtain these grants and we need your assistance.

Our main focus this month is for the 50th St and 250th Ave (County Line Road) improvement project. If you use, live, work along, or your business uses this road we need your support.
