Answering Roll Call were Park Chair (PC) Ashley Sarauer, Park Secretary (PS) Shannon Berg, Park Member (PM) Gary Pitts, and Village Treasurer/Deputy Clerk Teresa Dachel and Clerk Treasurer Stephanie Daniells. Public in attendance was Ashley Jarvinen-Pitts.

There were no public comments.

TDC Dachel explained where we are at in the Grant process for the Outdoor Recreation Grant amendment. Everything is in the hands of the DNR who will submit on our behalf and let us know if and when the amended changes are approved.

TDC Dachel tracked the folding chairs for purchase for the pavilion through the WI Surplus website. Unfortunately, the final cost was way over what the park committee allotted per chair. We will continue to watch for future sales.


TDC Dachel informed the committee that due to staffing shortage, the glass board installation in the pavilion bathrooms will be delayed.
