

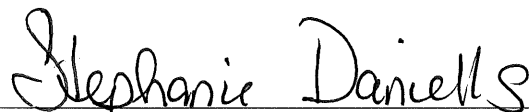
In accordance with the provisions of Section 19.84 Wisconsin Statutes:

Village Park Committee

on Tuesday, June 23, 2026 at 5:00 p.m.

Held at the Village Hall located at 130 E Elm Street, New Auburn

1. Call to Order. Park Chair Ashley Sarauer called the meeting to order at 5:00 p.m.
2. Roll Call. Answering roll call were Park Chair (PC) Ashley Sarauer, Park Member (PM) Ashley Jarvinen-Pitts, (PM) Gary Pitts. Park Secretary (PS) Shannon Berg was not in attendance. Village Staff in Attendance were Clerk-Treasurer Stephanie Daniells and Deputy Clerk-Treasurer Teresa Dachel.
3. Public Comments. There were no public comments.
4. Jamboree Committee.
 - a. Jamboree Meeting Update. PC Sarauer stated that she was unable to attend the last Jamboree Committee meeting but plans to attend the next meeting. PC Sarauer and PM Jarvinen-Pitts are currently recruiting volunteers to assist with food preparation, serving, and sales during Jamboree Days. DCT Dachel confirmed that a request for volunteers was also included in the June Village Newsletter. PC Sarauer and PM Jarvinen-Pitts discussed the menu items that will be offered; however, they are awaiting pricing information from Shadick's before finalizing. PM Jarvinen-Pitts mentioned The New Auburn Cheese Company has roasters available to use to keep food hot. PM Pitts also said he has a couple roasters that would be available.
 - b. NAFD fryer proposal. PM Jarvinen-Pitts relayed that she heard back from Tom Bischel regarding use of the Fire Departments fryers. They are willing to rent the fryers for \$150.00 each with a \$200.00 deposit. She stated he also mentioned another option was that NAFD would be willing to sell the fryers for \$1000.00 paid over a 4 yr period. PM Pitts stated he has two turkey fryers that would work just as well. They have been used for previous events and are available to use at no charge.
5. Fundraising Update – for Park Improvement Project. DCT Dachel stated no donations have been made at this time and no update on Inez North regarding the potential implementation of a QR code for online donations.
6. Lions Club Sign – Restoration of sign to hang at the park Pavillion. PC Sarauer described the current condition of the sign. The paint is peeling off in large sections and she has concerns that it may be lead paint. She said could make a new sign instead of restoring it. DCT Dachel suggested putting a coat polyurethane over the existing paint and not sanding or scraping the original paint off. This is a historical sign that would be hung up at the park pavilion. PC Saurer will continue to evaluate the sign to see what will work best to restore it.
7. Future Meetings – PC Saurer has requested a change to the next Park Committee meeting date because it falls immediately before Jamboree Days. The next Park Committee Meeting will be held on Tuesday, July 7, 2026, at 5:00 p.m. instead of its previously scheduled date.
8. Adjourn. Motion by PC Sarauer to adjourn the Park meeting at 5:40 p.m.
