Park Chair Ashley Sarauer called the meeting to order at 5:00 p.m.

Answering roll call were Park Chair (PC) Ashley Sarauer, Park Member (PM) Ashley Jarvinen-Pitts, (PM) Gary Pitts. Park Secretary (PS) Shannon Berg. Village Staff in Attendance was Clerk-Treasurer Stephanie Daniells. Deputy Clerk-Treasurer Teresa Dachel was not in attendance.

There were no public comments.

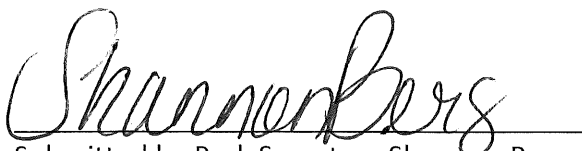
A Village resident requested permission to plant a tree in memory of a family member at the Village Park. PS Berg stated that Public Works employees should determine the appropriate location for the tree. PM Pitts noted that a tree had recently been removed and suggested that location as a suitable planting site. There is already a tree by the memorial so he advised not to plant it there.

PC Sarauer reviewed the food list and pricing received from Shadick's. Per Sandy at Shadick's a few of the items may not be available so PC Sarauer will check to see if another retailer has availability. She reported that she and PM Jarvinen-Pitts would finalize concession pricing later this week. The Shadick's food order will be picked up on July 22nd, with food preparation scheduled for the evening of July 23rd at NA Cheese Company. PC Jarvinen-Pitts stated that seven volunteers have committed to assisting with cooking and serving at the concession stand. PM Pitts provided additional names of potential volunteers for PC Sarauer to contact to help recruit more assistance. Currently, ten teams are registered for the softball tournament. PC Sarauer was unsure how many teams have registered for the volleyball tournament.

CT Daniells reported, on behalf of DCT Dachel, that there have been no changes to the status of fundraising for the Park Improvement Project.
